High Kelling Village Hall Dogs Policy

High Kelling Village Hall welcomes dogs under certain conditions. Before bringing a dog to the hall, owners should be aware that they must agree to the following conditions.

- 1. Only Assistance Dogs are allowed inside the hall building. Other dogs may be brought to the hall grounds but are not permitted inside the building.
- 2. Do not bring your dog to the hall grounds if your dog has a history of being aggressive to people or other dogs.
- 3. Dogs must be kept on leads, attended and restrained at all times when on hall grounds.
- 4. Ensure that leads do not cause a trip hazard to other users of the hall.
- 5. Ensure that you have appropriate cleaning products to deal with any circumstance that may arise.
- 6. Owners should ensure that their own personal liability insurance will cover them for any incidents arising. The hall Trustees do not accept responsibility for any liability arising from pets being on hall grounds.
- 7. Assistance Dogs are not allowed in the kitchen or bar areas for safety and hygiene reasons.
- 8. In wet weather, anyone accompanying someone with an Assistance Dog in the building is asked to check that the floor has not become slippery and to attend to it if required. (Mops etc are kept in the cleaning cupboard in the foyer.)
- 9. The hall Trustees Management Committee will request that dogs are removed from the grounds and/or may not return to the hall grounds if any of the above requirements are not met.
- 10. Water is available outside the hall. Water bowls should not be placed on the hall floor.
- 11. If a dog fouls in the hall grounds, please pick it up and dispose of it responsibly.
